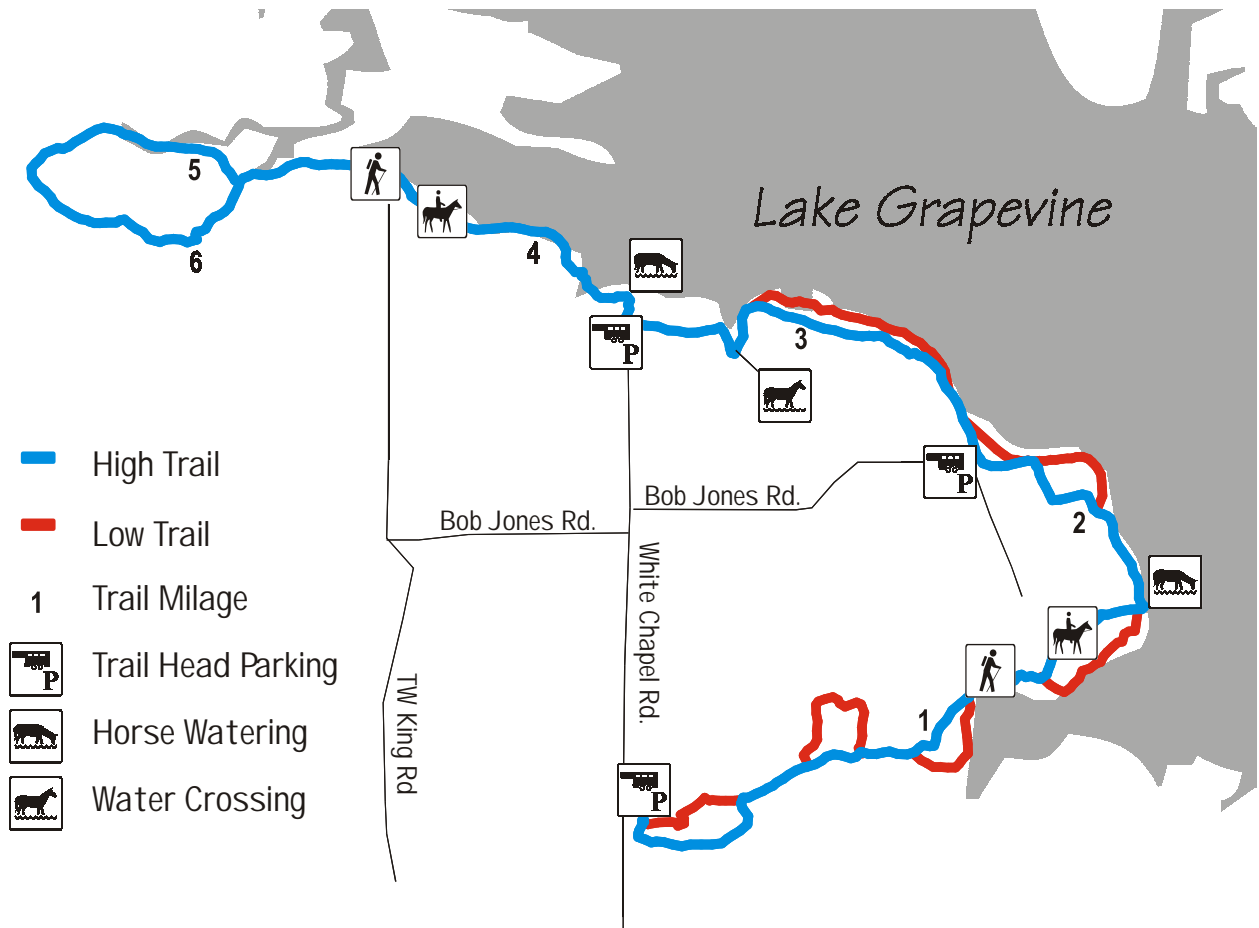
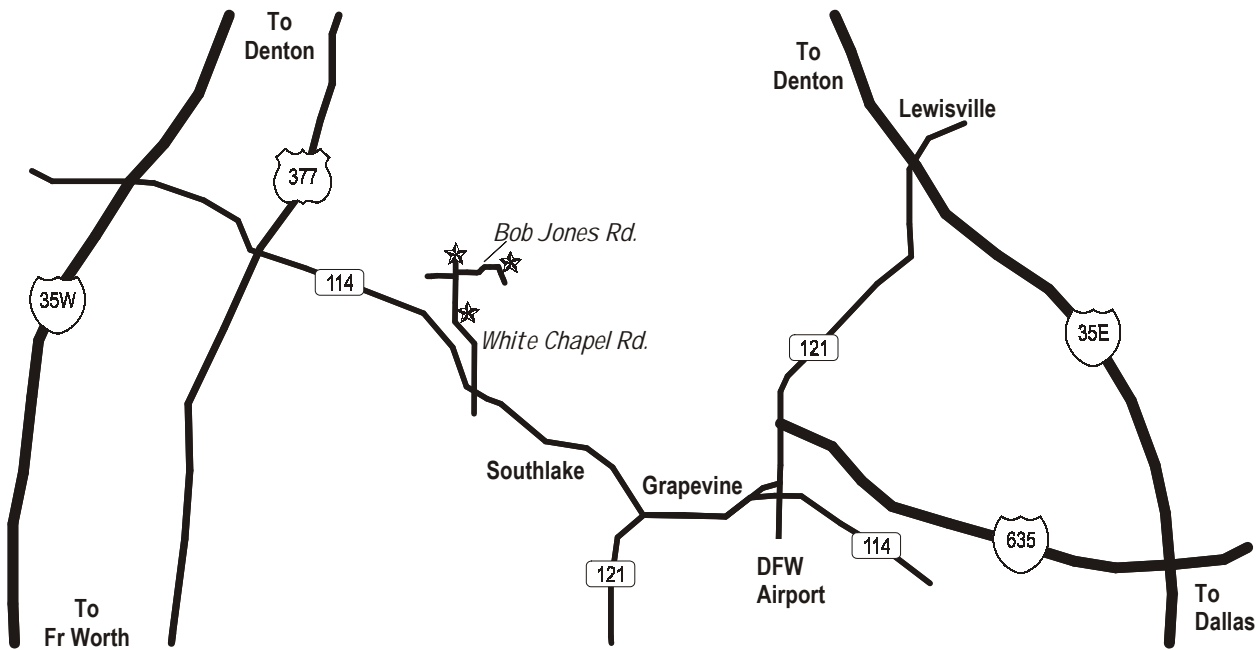


# Walnut Grove, Lake Grapevine

6 mi., linear,     
plus. side loops





**Configuration:** linear trail system with side loops.

**Length (one way):**  
Main Trail: 6 mi.

**Users:**  
equestrian, hikers

**Difficulty:** Easy, trail is wide with gentle slopes. However, a few creek crossings are relatively steep.

**Width:** moderate, mostly 2 horse side by side.

**Footing:** Sandy loam.

**Terrain:** Predominately open but surrounded by trees. Views of the water from the lower trail. Occasional thorn trees near trail, so be aware.

**Horseshoes:** Not required, recommended for tender footed horses.

**Water:** Bring your own, potential exists for watering horses from lake, but beware muddy conditions, as some beaches are boggy.

**Signage:** Limited, but improving, trail is easy to follow, but some unmarked false forks in the trail may lead riders astray.

**Challenges:** A couple of creek crossings are relatively steep. Restrooms exist near the soccer fields at the Bob Jones Park, but are as close as the nearest bush otherwise.

**Weather considerations:** Potential exists for lower trail to be underwater if lake extremely high. Low water crossings will be wet after rains. Trail status is available at (817) 481-3576

**Trailhead facilities:**

**White Chapel Road:** 

Three trailheads provide trailer parking. A large one capable of accommodating several trailers is in the northwest corner of Bob Jones Park. Two smaller ones capable of a few trailers exist on Corps property south of Bob Jones Park and at the end of White Chapel Rd.

**Bob Jones Rd:** 

Trailhead is at the bend of the road. Parking lot is small.

**Managing agency:** US Army Corps of Engineers, Fort Worth District

**Volunteer organization(s):** Cross Timbers Equestrian Trails Association

**Fees:** None to ride trails.
